RED WINES

Allan Scott Pinot Noir (2018) – Marlborough – 13%

This succulent Pinot Noir has aromas of spice, currant and dark Ghana chocolate. A juicy cherry mouthfeel matches perfectly with the grippy bitterness of the dark cocoa.

Lake Chalice ‘The Falcon’ Merlot (2018) – Hawkes Bay – 13.5%

Clean ripe red plums and subtle toasted oak on the nose followed by mulled spice, Morello cherries on the palate, fine tannins and a long finish.

Trout Valley Shiraz (2018) – Murray River – 13.5%

Sourced from seven local grape growers through the Nelson region, the shiraz is marked by rich, ripe red and black fruit flavours, with a hint of oak, black pepper and spices.

Brookfield’s Cabernet Sauvignon (2017) – Hawke’s Bay – 13.5%

Harvested in excellent condition, the wine exhibits concentrated blackberries, hints of blackcurrant, dried herbs, toast, leather and dried spice. The French oak is well integrated, thus creating palate complexity and weight to this generous wine.

Brookfield’s Syrah (2018) – Hawke’s Bay – 13%

The 2018 Back Block Syrah exhibits pepper, blackcurrant, plum and spice. The mid palate is bountiful in fruit and supported by the well-integrated oak.

Mahi Pinot Noir (2018) - Marlborough – 12.5%

A full and rich bouquet. This wine is mouth filling ripe and supple with good complexity. Dark cherries and plums combine with soft tannins to give a well-rounded finish. The wine shows complex savouriness characters aligned with both red & black fruit notes.

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WHITE WINES

Allan Scott Sauvignon Blanc - 2019 - Marlborough - 12.5%

Made from Tropical fruit with a fresh herbaceous character balanced with zesty passionfruit and a dry finish, this wine will take you straight back to the warmer summer days.

Mahi Sauvignon Blanc - 2018 - Marlborough - 13.5%

This wine shows an array of fruit characters ranging from citrus through to tropical notes. The palate has an elegant structure with a creamy, textural mid-palate and a long finish.

Selaks Buttery Chardonnay - 2018 - 13.5%

We've called this Chardonnay Buttery because it is smooth, creamy and simply melts in your mouth. The beautifully integrated toasty oak results in flavours of brioche and vanilla, while still enabling the delightful ripe stone fruit characters to shine through.

Jules Taylor Chardonnay - 2018 - Marlborough - 13%

Incredible fruit flavours with mouth-watering & mind blowing intensity.

The Ned Pinot Gris - 2019 - Marlborough - 13%

Instantly recognisable from its salmon pink colour, the 2019 vintage is delightfully aromatic featuring bright florals and ripe aromas of white peach and honeydew with hints of baking spice. The harmonious palate is fresh and full of flavour — a delicious example of cool climate Marlborough Pinot Gris.

Mahi Pinot Gris - 2019 - Marlborough - 13.5%

Vibrant, intense, spicy, fruity and complex attack with aromas of lemon and sweet hay, fresh bell-pepper, a creamy barrel ferment layer, golden kiwi and gooseberry. All these ideas turn into flavours on the palate emphasised by acidity, warming alcohol and a core of varietal lusciousness.

Jules Taylor Rose - 2018 - Gisborne - 13%

This Rosé is brimming with gorgeous raspberry, watermelon and aromas of candied toffee. The palate is fresh and juicy with bright red berry flavours and a dash of delicate spice, a nice balance and a dry, fruit filled finish.
